8. PESTICIDE CLASSIFICATION AND USE:

No pesticides on the EPA list classified as human carcinogen, probable human carcinogen or likely human carcinogen are to be applied to GEHMS or on any of its grounds.

Lawn care pesticides at the elementary and middle school levels may only be applied in emergency situations [e.g., direct exposure to insects (bees, ticks, etc.) and poisonous plants (poison ivy)] as of 01 July 2010 per Public Act No. 09-56 – an act concerning pesticide applications at child day care centers and schools.

Areas within a school property which house utilities such as power lines, transformers and natural gas dispensing equipment are not included as part of the turf and ornamental plan. These areas fall under the “rights of way” category and are not affected by the IPM laws or the pesticide ban legislation. Nonetheless, every attempt is made in earnest to manage these areas with the same safe practices and communication with the Principal of GEHMS.
